The title story, "Forms ofDevotion," is a wonderful literary cataloguing of the traits and qualities of the faithful, those who "sail off to work, perfect confident that they will indeed get there: on time, intact. It does not occur to them that they could just as well be broadsided by a Coca-Coladelivery truck running the red light at the corner of Johnson and Main." "Five Small Rooms" is an intriguing, spectral journey into then arrator's imagination, with the reader left wondering, "Is it madnessor a murder mystery?" In "How Deep is the River," the author offers an innovative, completely compelling take on the ubiquitous high schoolmath problem that begins "Train A and Train B are traveling toward the same bridge from opposite directions..."
