Their views reflect the trade importance of rapidly growing countries such as Korea, the central role of debt and trade linkages for developing countries and the special trade problems facing African economies. The editor also edited the second volume of this study, "General Equilibrium Trade Policy Modelling", "Perspectives on a U.S. Canadian Free Trade Agreement" and "Trade Liberalization among Major World Trading Areas".
